Uri Feinberg has worked in the field of Jewish education since 1995 and has been a licensed tour educator for 11 years.

Emigrating from the US with his family when he was 10, Uri grew up in Jerusalem, served in the IDF and traveled the world. He graduated from the Hebrew University of Jerusalem in 2004 with an MA in Contemporary Jewry. He also holds a BA in History and Literature.
