Muki was born in South Africa and grew up deeply involved in the local Jewish community, and was heavily active in the Habonim-Dror youth movement. In 1987, Muki made Aliyah to Kibbutz Tuval where he was active in setting up the Kibbutz Seminar Center, which dealt with Galilee issues such as settlement and co-existence. While studying at the Institute of Contemporary Judaism at the Hebrew University he taught at the Machon LeMadrachim (Institute for Youth Leaders from Abroad) became first a senior teacher specializing in History and Hadracha (leadership) and then the educational coordinator of the program, emphasizing the idea that being a Jewish leader means being an educated Jew. Muki became Director of Educational Services of the JCC Association, and later, a Senior Educator on the JDC Buncher Community Leadership Program, training Jewish community leaders in the emerging communities of Eastern Europe, the FSU and India, focusing on strengthening Jewish Identity and developing leadership skills and attitudes.

Muki lives in Modi'in with his wife, Mandy and two boys Shaked and Niv, where he is an active member of the Yozma Progressive Jewish community.
